The organising committee were outstanding in their attention to detail, and the hours of careful planning were vindicated. The local Eagles in Hawke's Bay came out in their droves to help and look at the golf, and it was great to welcome Tom Whitaker, national president, and Kevin Murphy, national patron, as well as Brian Marcroft from Waikato, who came to observe. A highlight for us locals was the presentation of life membership to Greg Bennetts, our previous club captain, who is extremely unwell.

A real feature of the tournament was the excellent attitude of the players. I commented at the welcome how nice it was to see a clubhouse full of young people and bubbly enthusiasm. The players all acquitted themselves very well, and there was some wonderful golf. The high standard of etiquette was gratifying, the pace of play was favourably commented on by the referees, and the sportsmanship, skill and maturity of the players was exemplary. We thoroughly enjoyed their company – they can come back to the Bay any time!
